In R.E. we will be: Exploring and comparing beliefs within Christian, Islamic and Jewish faiths.

We will finish the term using our knowledge of story writing to create our own fictional story with a moral. We will include key features such as using adverbs, similes and expanded noun phrases.

In P.E. we will be: exploring P.E both indoor and outdoor. Children will be learning a variety of skills using different techniques. We also have sports day to look forward to this term.

As READERS we will be: Clarifying, making predictions and summarising books. We will also be asking and answering questions about our class text and information texts linked to our topic. We will continue to read our books at home and school, these books will be closely linked to our phonics level. We will continue to bring home school books to share with an adult who can read it with us.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be learning to:

Multiply and Divide

Position and Direction

Measure, capacity, volume and mass.

In HISTORIANS we will be: Learning about significant people, specifically Amy Johnson to compare how they have influenced changes to society and what she achieved.

In DT we will be: developing skills to be able to sew using a needle and thread to create a beach themed piece of tapestry.

In PSHE -In Jigsaw we will: Follow the Changing Me unit where we will work on understanding changes in our growing bodies.
