### **Starting Secondary School September 2025**

If your child is currently in Year 5, moving into Year 6 in September - you will receive a letter from Hull City Council early in September asking you to apply for a secondary school place.

It is important you look out for this letter and apply as soon as you are able to as late applications may not always be allocated to their first choice of secondary school.

If you are planning on applying to St Mary's College, Sirius Academy West or Archbishop Sentamu Academy based on the 'ability' criteria, you must check the school's website for information on when testing is to be done.
